WAIVER AGREEMENT AND RELEASE OF CLAIMS

I hereby release and discharge the Defeat of Jesse James Days Committee, Inc., a Minnesota non-profit corporation (hereinafter referred to as the Committee), the City of Northfield, a municipal corporation (hereinafter referred to as the City) both of Rice County, Minnesota, their agents, employees, and officers, from all claims, demands, and actions which I may have or which my heirs, executors, or assigns may have against them for all personal injuries and property losses caused by, or arising out of the tractor-4/wheel drive truck pull held in conjunction with the Defeat of Jesse James Days promotion and celebration.

I acknowledge and assume the risk of the inherent dangers involved in the tractor pull and exhibition events, including, but not limited to, the risks that: my tractor/4-wheel drive truck and other tractors/4-wheel drive trucks may explode, go out of control, or be driven in a careless manner; my tractor/4-wheel drive truck may get damaged or destroyed by vandalism or carelessness; and I may be injured by mistakes made by myself or other people involved in the events.

I accept responsibility for all of the risks involved in and related to the tractor/4-wheel drive truck pull and exhibition, including the likelihood of serious injury and death. I affirm that I am over 18 years of age and not under the influence of alcohol or drugs.

I understand that my own motor vehicle and/or property insurance may exclude this activity from coverage. I have read this release and understand all of its terms. I voluntarily sign this release with full knowledge that neither I nor my representatives will be able to commence an action or suit in any forum against or hold the Committee or the City liable for such injuries or damages.

This agreement shall be construed under the laws of the State of Minnesota.
